

DIGITAL MICHIGAN NEWSPAPERS - HISTORICAL SOCIETY OF CASEVILLE

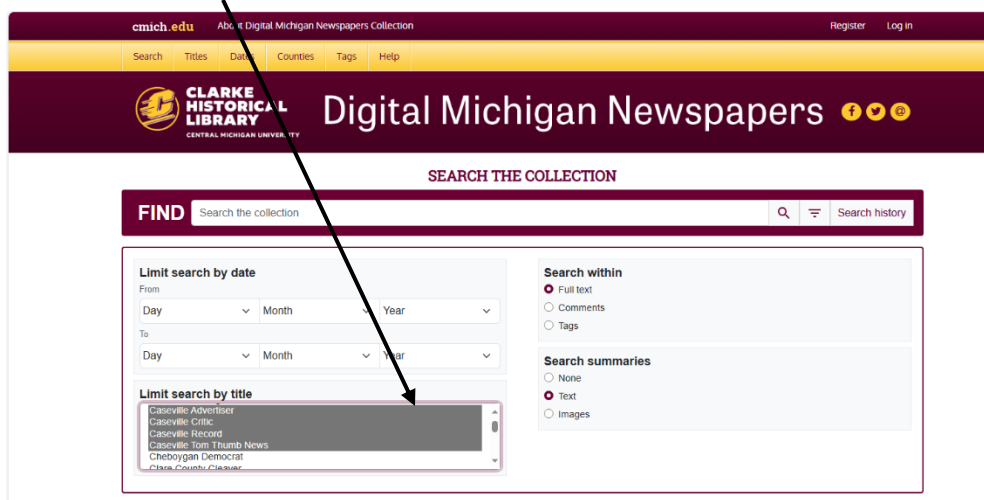
The Historical Society of Caseville has completed the Newspaper Digitization Project with the assistance of the *Clarke Historical Library at Central Michigan University*. We have digitized newspapers **from 1874 to 1960**. These newspapers include the following: **Caseville Advertiser, Caseville Critic, Caseville Record and Caseville Tom Thumb News**. This project took many volunteer hours to complete, and we are excited to share this news with the community, the state of Michigan, and others who may be interested in researching Caseville news from those years.

In order to access and search the digitized newspapers, please use the following steps:

1. Go to the website: <https://digmichnews.cmich.edu/>
2. Click on the little lines (highlighted in yellow) and a box of limiters will open.



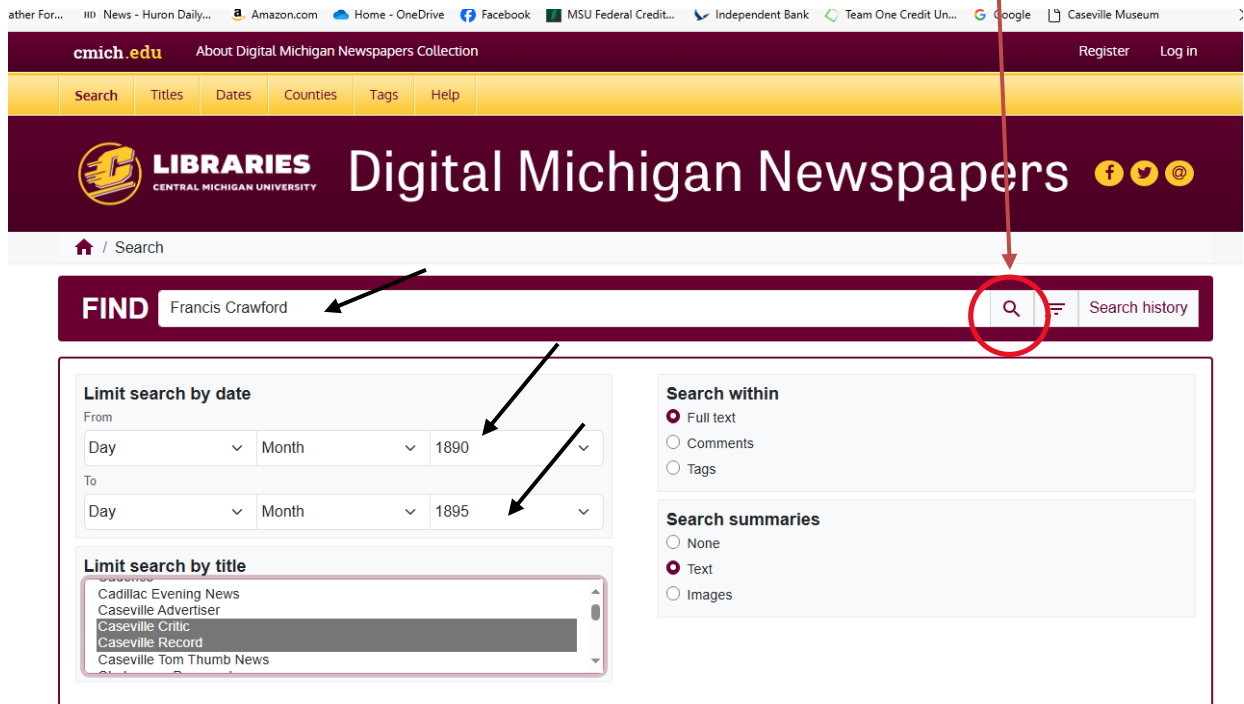
3. From the **Box of Limiters**, you can select your newspapers:



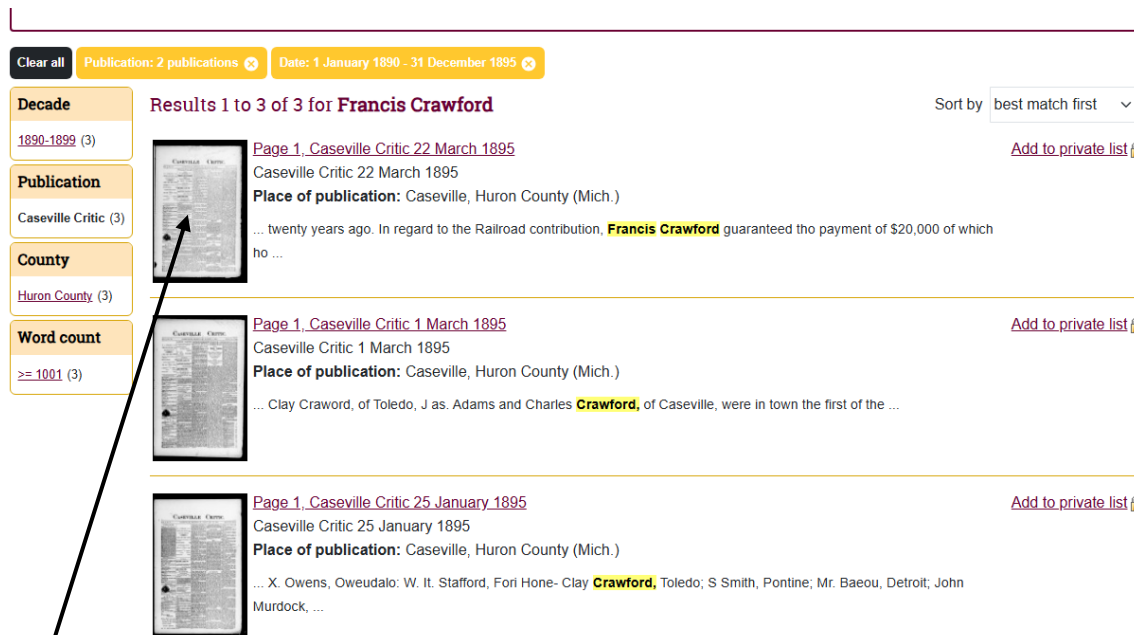
Hint: To select multiple titles, hold down the ctrl Key and click each title.

In the “**FIND**” box, type in the text you wish to search for. It can be one word or multiple words. Ex., **Francis Crawford**. You can also set **date parameters**. Then click on the **Search** icon:
